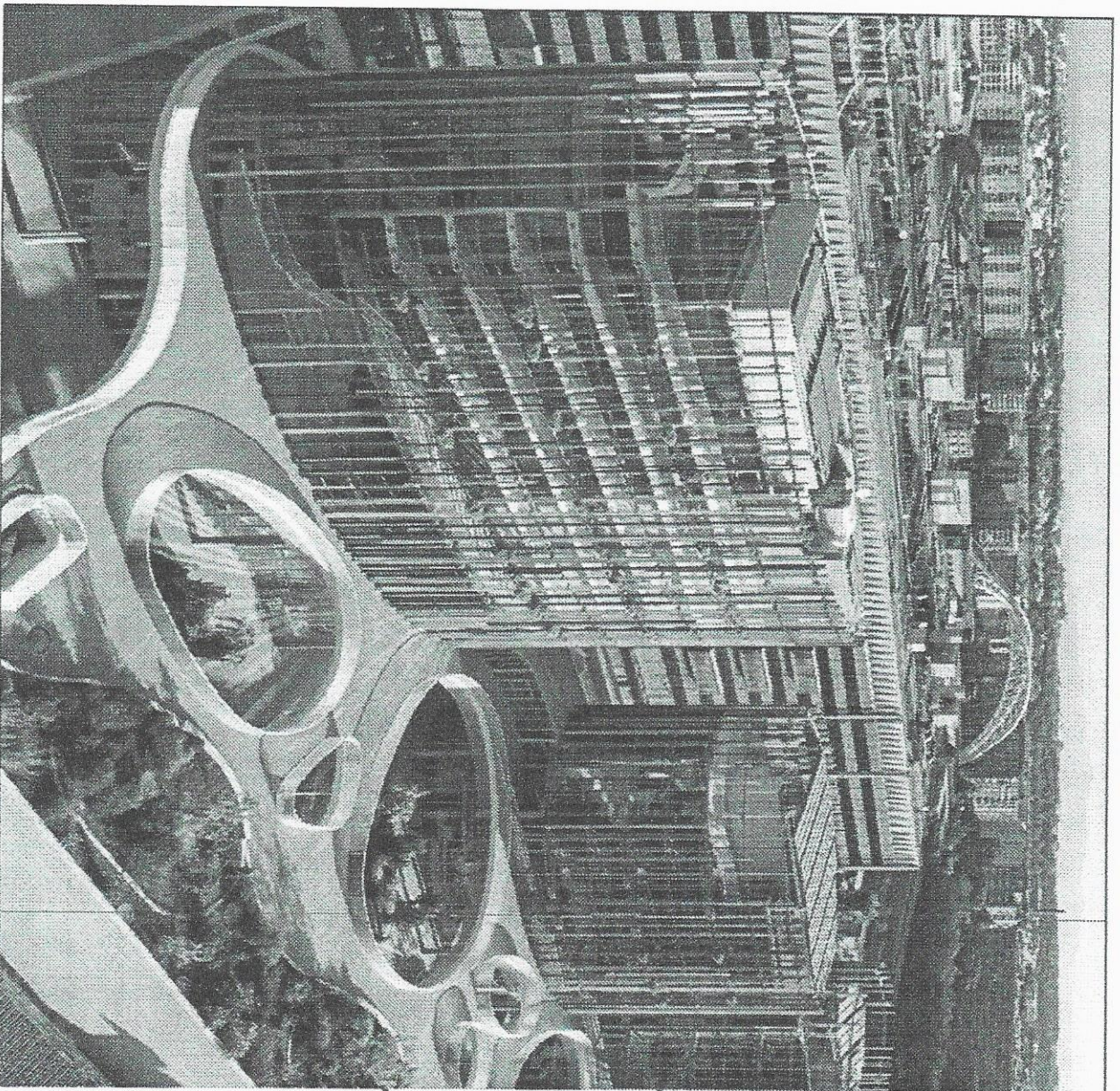

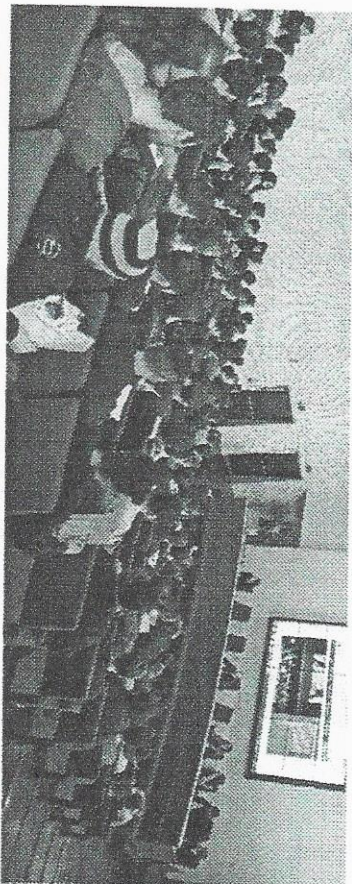
The New Headquarters

Roma Tre University

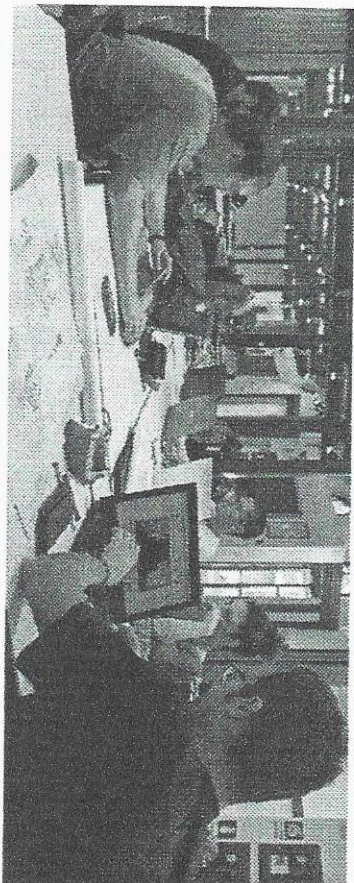
- Founded in 1992, Roma Tre University has gained a significant reputation in the academic community thanks to its high-quality teaching and research programmes.

» About 60% of our students are enrolled in Bachelor programmes, 30% in Master's Degrees and 10% at doctoral level.

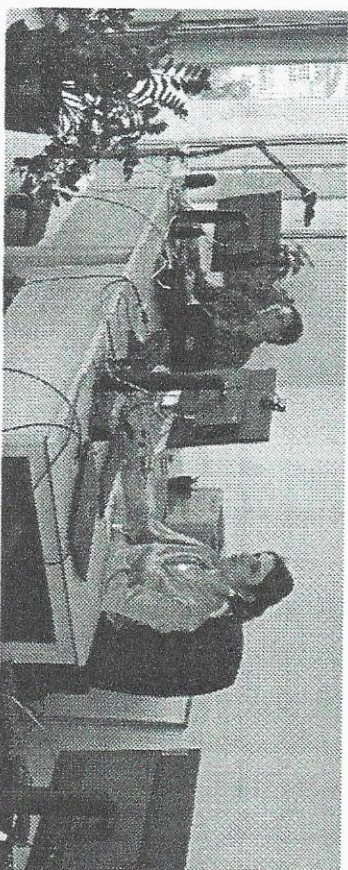

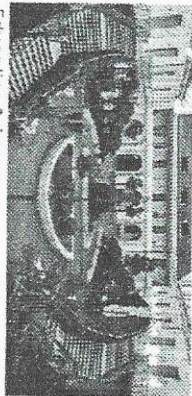

Departments

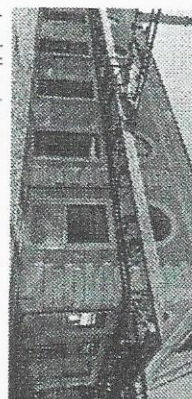

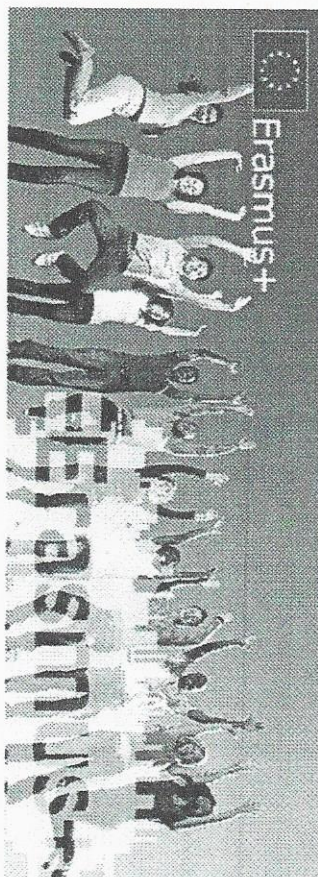
- Research integrated education programmes are hosted in an elegant fusion of academics and visual arts.

- Roma Tre University is one of Italy's top universities for graduate employability and it is leading the way in offering its students internship programmes that accompany their academic curricula to real on-the-job-training experiences.
- Roma Tre University issues the Certification of Italian as a Foreign Language, which is officially recognised by the Italian State through the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and organises many language courses, including intensive Italian for foreigners.

- We also offer 8 Internal Curricula of Degree Courses entirely in English. All other degree courses offer Single Courses and Classes in English and other foreign languages.

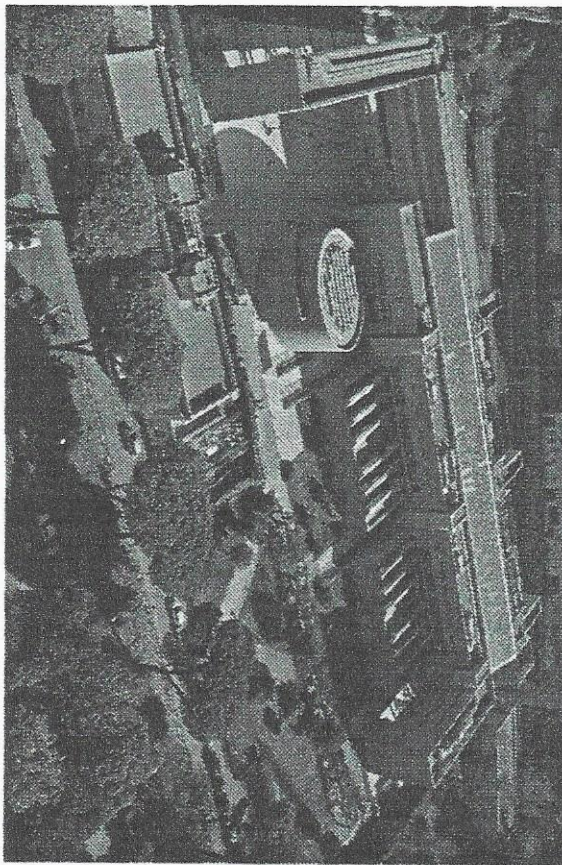

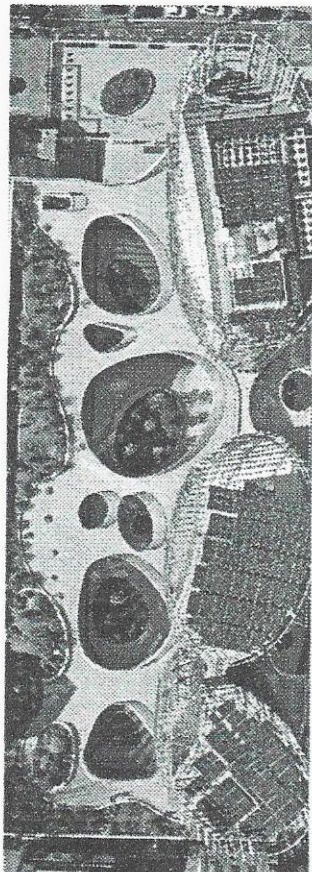
Territory and Sustainability

► Roma Tre is an urban university, and its premises are refurbished industrial buildings: our factories of knowledge. Our Law Department is located in the former San Paolo Glassware factory; our Department of Foreign Literatures is housed in a former Alfa Romeo car dealer; our Mathematics and Physics Department occupies a former parachute factory; our Engineering Department is headquartered in a converted naval tank, and our Architecture Department is situated in a former slougherhouse.



► The architectural structures of its premises, old and discontinued industrial plants in the city transformed into factories of ideas and knowledge, have modified the surrounding territory, bringing urban value to the entire quadrant. The buildings' extraordinary aesthetics have brought about complementary relationships between form and substance, becoming attractive meeting points for students and Rome residents.

► Located in the heart of Rome, Roma Tre is spread throughout the Ostiense, Marconi, San Paolo and Garbatella areas, but also in Rome's centre: in the Monti district, near the Termini train station, in Piazza della Repubblica. We also have offices in Ostia, Latina, and Albano Laziale.



► Roma Tre has rewritten the history of the city's south-eastern area by demonstrating great innovation, long-term vision, risk-taking, and investment in the territory. Through publicly funded Programme Agreements, we have been able to utilize many publicly owned venues, while other buildings have been purchased over the years.

► Starting from the initial 12,000 m² of available spaces at its foundation, today Roma Tre has grown to have real estate assets that extend over approximately 400,000 m² of enviable research, education and management facilities: 33,000 m² of classrooms, 16,000 m² of scientific laboratories, 16,000 m² of libraries, 25,000 m² of teachers' offices, and 200,000 m² of outdoor space.

Roma Tre in the World

Roma Tre's Development Strategy places a strong emphasis on international relations, inter-university and development cooperation, international mobility, double and joint degrees, as well as a robust visiting professors policy and involvement in EU projects. These efforts have resulted in Roma Tre being the first Italian University in terms of the number of international agreements.

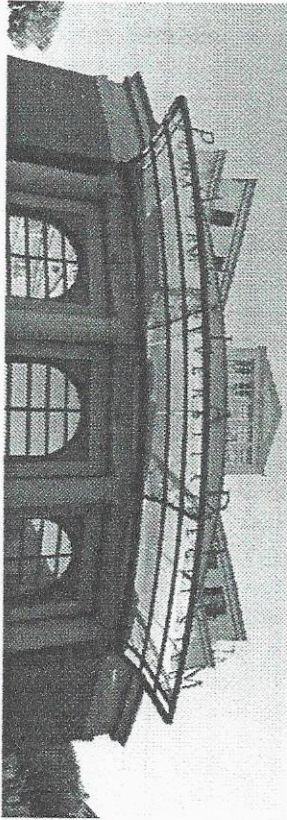

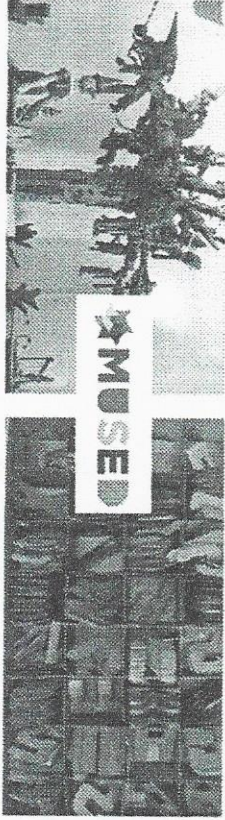


The Arts at Roma Tre

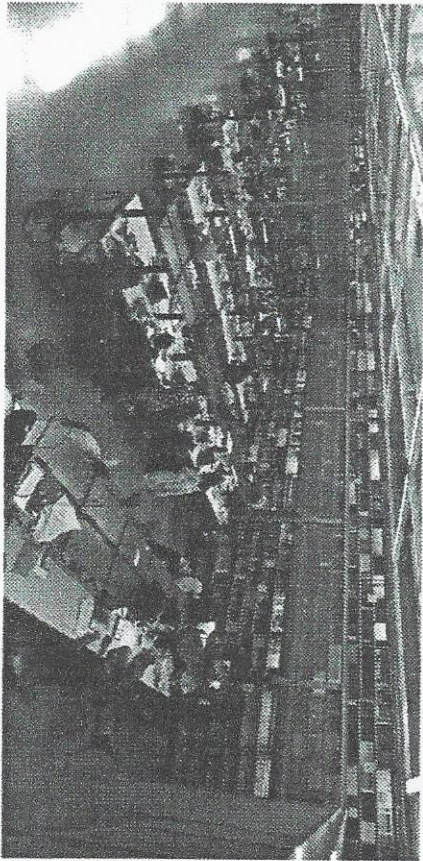
Sports at Roma Tre

Roma Tre offers its students and staff a variety of sports facilities including the Alfredo Berra stadium and the Le Tomi Sports Club. Additionally, the university promotes its sports teams in multiple athletic activities such as football, sailing and table tennis.



Factories of Knowledge

- » Twenty years after its foundation, Roma Tre is a highly identifiable university within the Italian higher education system.
- » This University proves that, in order to make history, a long-standing post is not the only thing you need - despite the fact that its original core, the Faculty of Education, had Luigi Pintor (who created its predecessor).
- » Roma Tre University provides 19 multidisciplinary libraries on campus with over 1.300 workstations. Its collection includes more than 650.000 documents and e-documents.



- » Roma Tre has taken its commitment to academic excellence a step further by establishing its own original publishing house, Romafire Press. It is an open access academic publisher, promoting wide dissemination of high-quality research products. Romafire Press exclusively publishes its content in open access and has documented more than 1.100 open documents of the 355 titles available in its catalog.
- » Roma Tre Ruido is the voice of Roma Tre University. Run by students and young professionals, it broadcasts a variety of programmes and news updates on music, culture, education, and current affairs.
